UTSA AT A GLANCE: With four Conference USA series left in the regular season, UTSA heads into the weekend in sixth place in the standings. The Roadrunners won its last C-USA tilt against Florida Atlantic behind a complete game shutout from southpaw Nolan Trabanino. UTSA has now won three of its last four league series. The Roadrunners also head into the weekend off a 10-2 victory over Houston Baptist on Tuesday, outscoring the Huskies 28-8 this season in a home-and-home series. Offensively, UTSA is fourth as a team batting a .300 average and ranks in the top five in seven offensive categories, including topping the circuit in triples (13). Individually, Ben Brookover leads five players batting .300 or better with his .379 average. Brookover has recorded at least one hit in 18 of his last 20 games, including a 14-game hit streak. Meanwhile, Kevin Markham adds a .346 average to the lineup with a team-best 56 hits, including 25 extra base hits. Markham has registered multi-hits in four of his last five contests. On the other side of the ball, UTSA has been consistent with two of its pitchers in Trabanino and Tyler Giovanoi. The two combine for 102.2 innings and 70 strikeouts.

OPPONENT AT A GLANCE: The perennial powerhouse has struggled this season as the Rice Owls own a 16-25 overall record and a 7-11 mark in C-USA (T9th in standings). It will mark the second time Rice has not won a regular season or conference tournament title since joining C-USA. The Owls head into the weekend off its sweep of WKU on the road - the first of the season. As a team, the Owls are hitting a C-USA eighth (tie) best .279 average and are led by Dominic DiCaprio at the plate. DiCaprio is batting .348 on the season and is second on the team in hits (49) while leading the club in RBI (31) and walks (20). On the mound, Zach Esquivel leads the Owls' pitching staff with a 3.10 ERA in 16 appearances, including nine starts, and 58 innings tossed. Esquivel is 4-4 on the season, has one save and pitched in combined shutout. He is second on the staff with 49 strikeouts.

Last time out

SAN ANTONIO — Steven Dressler gave up just one run in five innings and that helped UTSA post a 10-2 victory against Houston Baptist on Tuesday night at Roadrunner Field.

Dressler allowed three of Houston Baptist's five hits to earn the win and improve to 3-3 on the season. The Roadrunners bullpen then combined for four innings and allowed one run on two hits.

UTSA (21-18) now has outscored Houston Baptist (20-16) by a combined score of 28-8 this season after defeating the Huskies 18-6 back on March 21.

The Roadrunners scored their 10 runs in just two innings with a three-run third and seven-run fifth.

Dressler and Houston Baptist starter Tanner Luna worked quickly through the order in the first two innings before Luna ran into trouble.

Eight Roadrunners stepped to the plate in the third and were on the bases quick after back-to-back walks to Mason George and Skyler Valentine. Jesse Baker singled to drive in George for the first run of the evening and was followed by Kevin Markham's RBI double. Two batters later, Ben Brookover singled up the middle and scored Markham for the third run of the stanza.

Huskies reliever Ivan Smith recorded the final out of the third and managed to get through the fourth with no damage but got off on the wrong foot after a hit by pitch, walk and back-to-back hits scored the first two runs in the fifth.

However, Houston Baptist's Cody Marshall also struggled on the hill, as he loaded up the bases on a pair of walks and a hit by pitch. Three more runs scored after Marshall was relieved to end the Roadrunners' rally.

Brookover has now recorded a hit in 17 of the last 18 games after finishing the night 3-for-5 with two RBIs and a run. Markham added a 2-for-3 performance with three RBIs, two runs scored and a double.

Diamond Notes

UTSA **continued** its **streak** at the end of the 2016 season of players either drafted or signed as free agents. Shortstop **Tyler Straub** made that happen when he was **selected** by the **Kansas City Royals organization**. The streak extends back to the 1997 season.

The Roadrunners were selected to finished tied for **10th** in this year's **Conference USA Preseason Poll** while senior outfielder **Jesse Baker** earned a spot in the **Preseason All-Conference Team**after sitting out the 2016 season. UTSA tied with Middle Tennessee, who finished at the bottom of the rankings last season.

Another tough schedule is ahead for the Roadrunners in 2017 as they face **six** teams (Utah, Texas Tech, Louisiana Tech, Florida Atlantic, Rice, Southern Miss), including **four** that hail from **Conference USA**, who earned a **regional berth** in **2016**.

A new site will be in store for the 2017 edition of the Conference USA Baseball Championship. The city of Biloxi, Miss. will be the host site at the MGM Park - the home of the Biloxi Shuckers. The tournament will be an eight team, double elimination event.

The **2016 season** was **plagued** with **injuries** with three of the team's big hitters out, along with southpaw Nolan Trabanino. The **four seniors return** for the **2017 campaign** while head baseball coach Jason Marshall **also returns** a **core** of his **lineup** from last season. The Roadrunners will be a force to play against in Conference USA.

Since the program's inception in 1992, the Roadrunners have gone **11-14** in **season openers** and have **won** each of its **last four Opening Days** under the direction of Jason Marshall. He is the fastest coach in program history to reach 100 wins.

UPDATE: UTSA dropped its first Opening Day game in six years and moves to 11-15 overall in season openers.

The **2017** season will mark the **sixth consecutive season** that the UTSA baseball team **opens at home**. The last time the Roadrunners hit the road for Opening Day was back in 2011 when the team opened at Louisiana Monroe.

UTSA has some kinks to work out after opening weekend. The Roadrunners committed **nine errors** over **four games** but blasted **nine home runs** with three coming from junior Skyler Valentine. The junior matched his career mark of two in a game against the Bobcats on Opening Day.

Four seniors stepped foot on the field for the first time in live action this weekend. Jesse Baker, Kevin Markham, Geonte Jackson and Nolan Trabanino all stepped foot on the diamond after missing the 2016 season. Markham had the best performance going 9-for-20 for a .450 batting average. The Willis native totaled seven doubles, scored six runs and posted a .950 slugging percentage.

In its second weekend series of the season, UTSA earned the sweep over Stephen F. Austin. The Roadrunners scored 10-plus runs in the first two games and secured the sweep with a 9-5 victory on Sunday.

If you haven't been to a Roadrunners game lately, you wouldn't know that **UTSA** has now recorded **13 home runs** total **this season** and has **hit** at **least one** in **each** of its **seven games**.

UPDATE: UTSA snapped its home run streak in the second game of the doubleheader against Utah.

Kevin Markham became the Roadrunners' second **hitter of the week** in **Conference USA** on **Feb. 27** after leading UTSA to a sweep of Stephen F. Austin. The senior outfielder batted .636 with a 1.091 slugging percentage and .733 on base percentage. He led the team in five offensive categories and extended his hit streak to seven straight. He matched a career best four hits in the series finale and matched season-bests of three runs scored and two RBIs in the second game of the series.

With Conference USA play just around the corner, the Roadrunners have compiled a **9-15** record in **conference openers** and are 3-1 under the tutelage of head coach Jason Marshall. UTSA has competed in three different conferences since its inception in 1992 and two different ones since 2013.

UPDATE: UTSA is now 10-15 in conference openers with its 4-2 victory over Marshall.

There's nothing like **handing** a team its **first loss** in **Conference USA** play and that's what **UTSA did** on **March 26** in the series finale against **Old Dominion**. The Monarchs were the only undefeated team in the league with a 5-0 mark but the Roadrunners pulled through with a go-ahead solo home run by Bryan Arias to put UTSA on top, 6-5. Chris Muller worked quickly in the top ninth to hold off ODU.

Despite the 12-11 record, UTSA has shown some impressive strides. The **Roadrunners** recorded its third win over a ranked opponent against **No. 21 Baylor** on a 15-9 victory on the road and is the most wins over ranked opponents in a season in program history. **Two** of the three wins over these ranked opponents have also come on the road. UTSA pulled out a dramatic 3-2 victory over then-No. 6 Texas Tech on March 11.

UTSA had its **longest win streak** of the season snapped in the second game of the Louisiana Tech series in the Roadrunners' first shutout of the season. The Roadrunners **four-game win streak** began in the final game of the Old Dominion series followed with a 15-9 upset victory over No. 21 Baylor and continued with the first two games of the **LA Tech series**. It was also the **first Conference USA series win** for UTSA this season.


